SECTION A

ECONOMIC INDICATORS AND TRENDS

1. CROP ESTIMATES AND FORECASTS

Areas planted and fourth production forecast for summer crops for the 2025 production season

According to the fourth production forecast for summer crops by the Crop Estimates Committee (CEC) for the 2025 production season, the expected commercial **maize** crop was 14,644 million tons, which is 14,0% or 1,794 million tons more than the 12,850 million tons of the 2024 season. The estimated area planted to maize by South African commercial maize producers during the 2025 season is 2,597 million ha—1,5% or 39 550 ha less than the 2,636 million ha planted the previous season. The expected yield is 5,64 t/ha.

The ratio of white to yellow maize plantings was estimated at 62:38. The estimated white maize plantings were 1,600 million ha, which is an increase of 2,9% from the previous season's plantings of 1,555 million ha. Yellow maize plantings were estimated to be 997 000 ha—7,8% less than the 1,081 million ha for 2024.

During the 2025 production season, most of the country's maize crop was planted in the Free State (46,0%), the North West (20,8%) and Mpumalanga (20,2%). The plantings of maize decreased by 4,4%, from 1,250 million ha to 1,195 million ha in the Free State Province. However, the plantings of maize increased by 1,9%, from 530 000 ha to 540 000 ha, in North West Province and by 0,8%, from 520 000 ha to 524 000 ha, in Mpumalanga Province for the 2025 season.

The production forecast for white maize was 7,648 million tons, which is 26,3% more than the 6,055 million tons of the previous season. The expected yield for white maize was 4,78 t/ha, as against 3,89 t/ha in 2024. In the case of yellow maize, the production forecast was 6,996 million tons, which is 3,0% more than the 6,795 million tons the previous season. The yield for yellow maize was expected to be 7,02 t/ha, as against 6,28 t/ha for 2024.

A **sunflower seed** crop of 727 800 tons was expected, which is 15,2% more than the 632 000 tons of the previous season. The area planted to sunflower seed was estimated at 555 700 ha, which is 5,0% higher than the 529 000 ha planted for 2024. The expected yield for 2025 was 1,31 t/ha, as against 1,19 t/ha in 2024.

The production forecast for **soya beans** was 2,331 million tons, which is 26,1% more than the 1,848 million tons of the previous season. The estimated area planted to soya beans was 1,151 million ha, which is 500 ha more than the 1,151 million ha planted for 2024. The expected yield was 2,03 t/ha, as against 1,61 t/ha in 2024.

The expected **groundnut** crop was 63 510 tons, which is 22,1% more than the 52 000 tons of the 2024 season. The area planted to groundnuts was estimated at 48 125 ha, which is 16,8% or 6 925 ha more than the 41 200 ha planted the previous season. The expected yield was 1,32 t/ha, as against 1,26 t/ha in 2024.

The production forecast for **sorghum** was 137 970 tons—40,8% more than the 98 000 tons of the previous season. The area planted to sorghum was estimated to be 41 150 ha, which is 2,3% or 950 ha less than the 42 100 ha planted for 2024. The expected yield was 3,35 t/ha, as against 2,33 t/ha the previous season.

The production of **dry beans** was expected to be 71 415 tons—41,4% more than the 50 495 tons of the previous season. The estimated area planted was 45 620 ha, or 15,4% more than the 39 550 ha planted the previous season, with an expected yield of 1,57 t/ha for 2025, as against a yield of 1,28 t/ha in 2024.

Intended plantings of winter crops for the 2025 production season

Producers' intentions to plant winter cereals are based on the results of a non-probability survey conducted by the Directorate: Statistics and Economic Analysis of the Department of Agriculture reflects the position as at the middle of April 2025.

The figures for wheat represent the total number of hectares that are intended to be planted for grain, excluding any hectares that will be planted for fodder and grazing.

Early indications are that producers intend to plant 513 200 ha of **wheat** for the 2025 season. This is 1,6% or 7 900 ha more than the 505 300 ha planted to wheat in 2024. The main producing areas are within the Western Cape with 371 000 ha (72%), followed by the Free State with 55 000 ha (11%) and the Northern Cape with 38 000 ha (7%).

The expected area planted to **barley** is 93 050 ha, which is 7,6% or 7 650 ha less than the 100 700 ha of the previous year. The expected area planted to **canola** is 166 500 ha, which is 0,4% or 750 ha more than the 165 750 ha planted in 2024. Producers intend to plant 34 520 ha of **oats**, which is 11,4% or 3 520 ha more than the 31 000 ha of the previous season. The expected area planted to **sweet lupines** is 20 700 ha, which is 29,4% or 4 700 ha more than the previous season.

3. ECONOMIC OVERVIEW

This article gives an overview of the major macroeconomic changes in the agricultural sector from the period 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2024 to the period 1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025.

Gross farming income


Gross farming income refers to the agricultural production that is marketed, together with the part that is for own consumption, both valued at basic prices.

Gross farming income from all agricultural products increased slightly by 0,9% to R456 927 million for the period ended March 2025, from R452 943 million the previous corresponding period. This was mainly driven by the increase in income from horticultural and animal products.

The income earned from field crops decreased by 10,8% and estimated at R113 613 million, due to the decreases in income from soya beans by 44,8%, wheat (10,2%), sunflower seed (8,3%), sugar cane (5,3%) and maize (1,4%).

The income from horticultural products increased by 6,3% to R144 607 million, compared to R136 019 million of the previous period. The main contributors were the income earned from subtropical fruit by 12,8%, viticulture by 10,0%, citrus fruit by 7,0%, deciduous and other fruit by 5,1% and vegetables by 2,5%.

The income from animal products increased by 4,9% from R198 707 million to R189 491 million, largely because of the increase in income from poultry meat by 8,5%, sheep slaughtered by 8,1%, cattle and calves slaughtered by 5,8% and eggs by 2,7%.



Expenditure on intermediate production inputs

Expenditure on intermediate production inputs refers to the value of the goods and services that were purchased to be consumed as inputs during the production process.

Expenditure on intermediate goods and services showed a decrease of 1,6% and is estimated to be R244 384 million during the period under review. This was largely driven by the decrease in expenditure on packing material by 16,4%, animal health and crop protection by 10,7%, farm feeds by 8,0% and seed and plants by 4,9%.

Farm feeds remained the largest expenditure item and accounted for approximately 26,8% to total expenditure on production inputs, followed by fertilisers (14,7%), farm services (10,8%), maintenance and repairs of machinery and implements (9,6%), fuel (8,9%), seed and plants (6,4%), packing material (5,3%), building and fencing material (4,7%) and animal health and crop protection and packing material (4,1%).

Prices received and prices paid by farmers, as well as terms of trade

Prices earned by the farmers for their agricultural products increased on average by 2,1% for the period ended March 2025. This was mainly the results of the increase in prices of field crops and animal products by 14,5% and 2,4%, respectively.


The weighted average price of field crops increased by 14,5%, as the result of the increase in prices of summer grains by 31,9%, sugar cane by 7,1%, hay by 5,5% and dry beans by 3,9%.

The decrease of 7,8% in the average price of horticultural products is attributed to the decrease in prices of vegetables by 24,7% and viticulture by 16,3%.

The weighted average price of animal products increased by 2,4% due to the increase in prices of poultry meat by 2,4% and slaughtered stock by 2,7%.

The prices paid for farming requisites, including machinery and implements, material for fixed improvements and intermediate goods and services, showed a decrease of 3,8% for the period ended March 2025. The reason for this was the decrease in prices of animal health and crop protection by 14,5%, fertilisers (3,4%) and fuel (3,3%).

Domestic terms of trade increased by 6,0% from 1,15 to 1,22 due to the increase in prices received by farmers for their agricultural products and a decrease 3,8% in prices paid for production inputs.



Net farm income and cash flow

The marginal increase of 0,9% in gross farming income and the 3,8% decrease in the expenditure on production inputs has caused the net farming income to increase by 2,8%. The interest payment showed an increase of 9,0%, labour remuneration (6,0%) and rent payment (3,3%).


The farmers' cash flow increased by 2,3% and is estimated at R126 825 million, compared to R123 986 million the previous period.

Conclusion

The increase in gross farming income was largely influenced by the increase in output levels of grain sorghum (124,7%), cattle and calves slaughtered (5,2%), poultry meat (3,7%), vegetables (2,3%), citrus fruit (1,7%), milk (1,4%) and dry beans (0,9%), as well as the increase in prices of summer grains (31,9%), fruit (7,5%), sugar cane (7,1%), hay (5,5%), poultry meat (4,2%), dry beans (3,9%) and slaughtered stock (2,7%).



SECTION B

FRESH PRODUCE MARKETS OVERVIEW

FRESH MARKET STATISTICS OF SEASONAL FLUCTUATIONS IN QUANTITIES AND PRICES OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES SOLD ON THE MAJOR FRESH PRODUCE MARKETS

The purpose of this overview is to show the short-term price and volume trends (seasonal fluctuations) of various types of fruit and vegetables sold on major fresh produce markets and to make comparisons between the markets.

Market prices are determined by the interaction between supply and demand, which is influenced by various factors. Supply factors include climate, seasonal production, perishability of products and producers' reaction to prices realised in preceding periods, etc. Demand factors include consumer preferences, substitution between products and per capita income. Therefore, the seasonal pattern of quantities sold, and prices realised, may differ considerably among the various markets.
