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## SECTION A

### ECONOMIC INDICATORS AND TRENDS

#### 1. CROP ESTIMATES AND FORECASTS

##### Areas planted and sixth production forecast for summer crops for the 2025 production season

According to the sixth production forecast for summer crops by the Crop Estimates Committee (CEC) for the 2025 production season, the expected South African maize crop was 15,031 million tons, which was 17,0% more than the 12,850 million tons of the 2024 season and 1,6% or 241 825 tons less than the five-year average of 15,273 million tons up to 2024.

The estimated area that South African commercial producers planted to maize during the 2025 season was 2,597 million ha. This was 1,5% or 39 550 ha less than the 2,636 million ha planted in the previous season. Of this area, 1,195 million ha (46,0%) were in Free State, 540 000 ha (20,8%) in North West and 524 000 ha (20,2%) in Mpumalanga.

The plantings of maize decreased by 4,4%, from 1,250 million ha to 1,195 million ha in Free State. However, the plantings of maize increased by 1,9%, from 530 000 ha to 540 000 ha, in North West and by 0,8%, from 520 000 ha to 524 000 ha, in Mpumalanga for the 2025 season.

The ratio of white to yellow maize plantings was estimated at 62:38. The estimated white maize plantings were 1,600 million ha, which is an increase of 2,9% from the previous season's plantings of 1,555 million ha. Yellow maize plantings were estimated to be 997 000 ha—7,8% less than the 1,081 million ha for 2024.

Most of the country's maize crop was produced in Free State (40,2%), Mpumalanga (24,6%) and North West (16,4%).

The production forecast for white maize was 7,736 million tons, which was 27,8% or 1,681 million tons more than the 6,055 million tons of 2024 and 175 600 tons less than the average of the five years up to 2024. The expected yield for white maize was 4,84 t/ha, as against 3,89 t/ha the previous season.

In the case of yellow maize, the production forecast was 7,295 million tons, which was 7,4% or 500 275 tons more than the 6,795 million tons of the previous season and 66 225 tons less than the five-year average up to 2024. The yield for yellow maize was expected to be 7,32 t/ha, as against 6,28 t/ha in 2024.

The expected sunflower seed crop was 708 300 tons, which was 12,1% more than the 632 000 tons of the previous season and 3,3% less than the average of 732 810 tons for the five years up to 2024. The area planted to sunflower seed was estimated at 555 700 ha, which is 5,0% higher than the 529 000 ha planted for 2024. The expected yield was 1,27 t/ha, as against 1,19 t/ha the previous season.

The production forecast for soya beans was 2,723 million tons, which was 47,3% more than the 1,848 million tons of the previous season. The estimated area planted to soya beans was 1,151 million ha, which is 500 ha more than the 1,151 million ha planted for 2024. The expected yield was 2,37 t/ha, as against 1,61 t/ha in 2024.

The expected groundnut crop was 61 389 tons, which was 18,1% or 9 389 tons more than the 52 000 tons of the 2024 season and 7 813 tons more than the five-year average of 53 576 tons per annum up to 2024. The area planted to groundnuts was estimated at 48 125 ha, which is 16,8% or 6 925 ha more than the 41 200 ha planted the previous season. The expected yield was 1,28 t/ha, as against 1,26 t/ha in 2024.

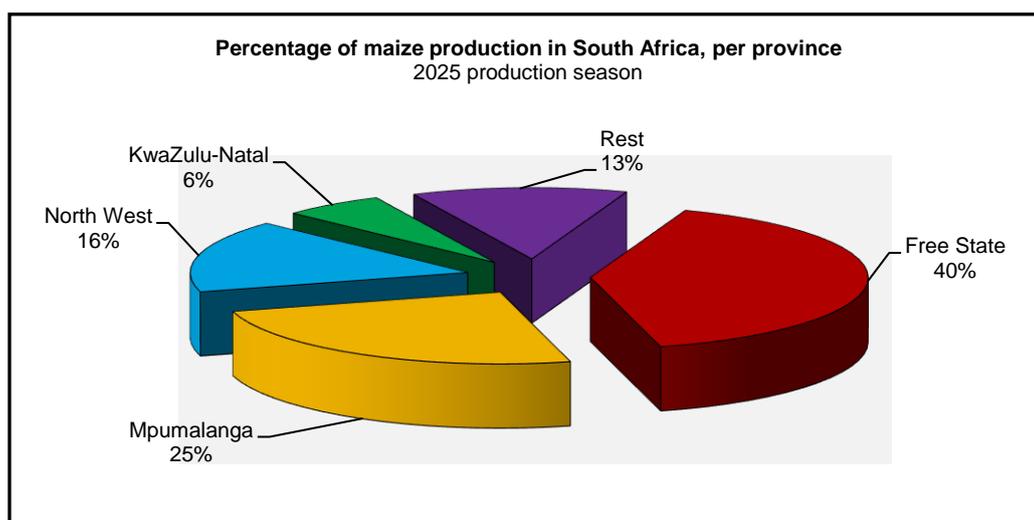
The production forecast for sorghum was 137 970 tons—40,8% more than the 98 000 tons of the previous season. The area planted to sorghum was estimated to be 41 150 ha, which is 2,3% or 950 ha less than the 42 100 ha planted for 2024. The expected yield was 3,35 t/ha, as against 2,33 t/ha the previous season.

The production of dry beans was expected to be 74 299 tons, which was 47,1% or 23 804 tons more than the 50 495 tons of the previous season and 19 136 tons more than the five-year average of 55 163 tons per annum up to 2024. The estimated area planted was 45 620 ha, or 15,4% more than the 39 550 ha planted the previous season. The expected yield was 1,63 t/ha, as against 1,28 t/ha for 2024.

### Preliminary estimate of the area planted to winter cereal crops for the 2025 production season

The CEC also released the preliminary area estimate for winter crops on 29 July 2025.

The estimate for wheat was 512 500 ha, which is 1,4% more than the 505 300 ha planted in 2024. The main wheat-producing area was in Western Cape, with 369 000 ha (72,0%), followed by Free State with 54 000 ha (10,5%) and Northern Cape with 38 000 ha (7,4%).

The preliminary area estimate for barley was 95 700 ha, which was 5,0% less than the 100 700 ha of the 2024 season.

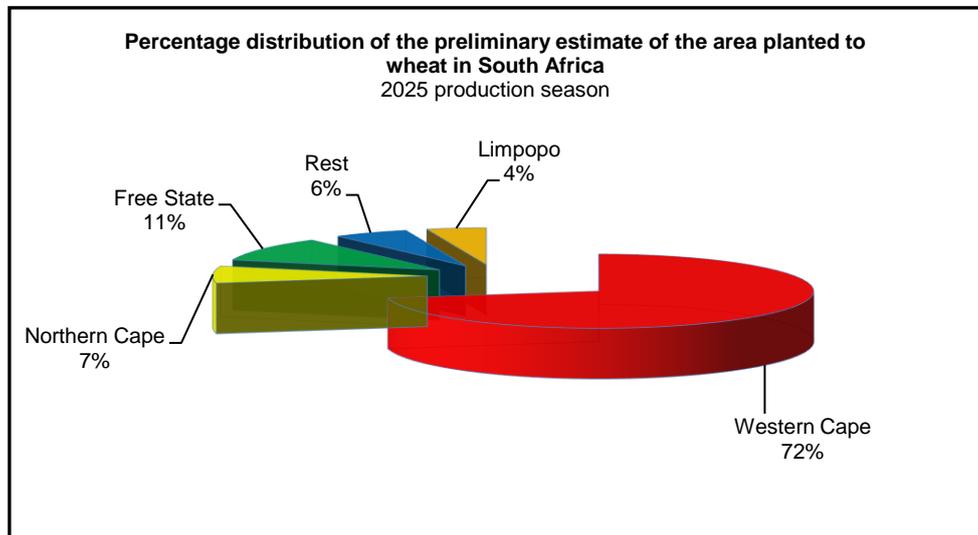
The area planted to canola was estimated at 164 900 ha, a decrease of 0,5% from the previous season's plantings of 165 750 ha.

The preliminary area estimate for oats for the 2025 season was 33 520 ha, which was 8,1% more than the 31 000 ha of the previous season.

The preliminary area estimate for sweet lupines for the 2025 season is 17 500 ha, an increase of 9,4% from the previous season's plantings of 16 000 ha.

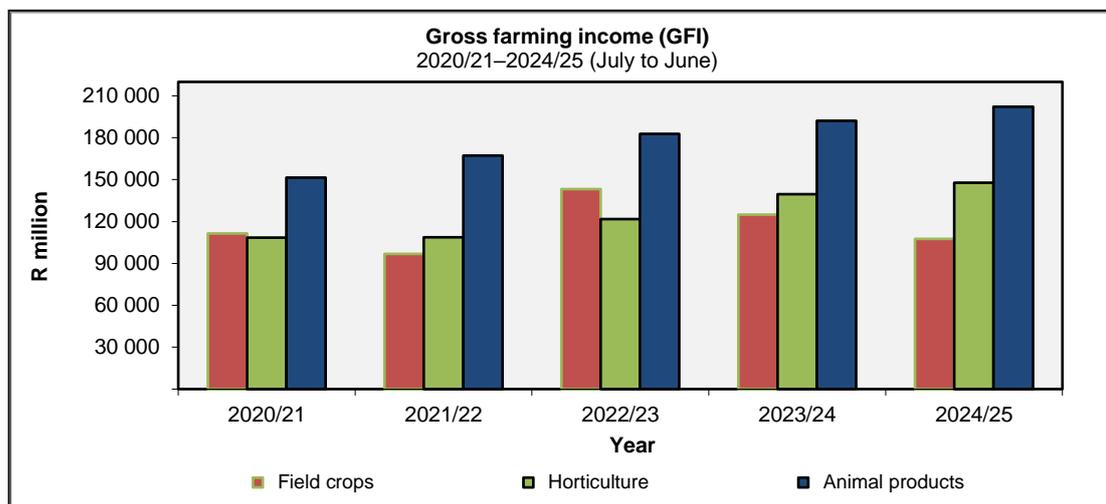
### 3. ECONOMIC OVERVIEW

This article gives an overview of the major macroeconomic trends in the agricultural sector for the period 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025. Aggregates are compared with the period 1 July 2023 to 30 June 2024.

#### Gross farming income

*Gross farming income refers to that part of agricultural production that is marketed, together with the part that is for own consumption, both valued at basic prices.*

Gross farming income that was earned from all agricultural products increased marginally by 0,2% to R457 487 million for the period ended 30 June 2025, opposed to R456 709 million the previous period. This can be attributed mainly to the increase in income from horticultural and animal products by 5,8% and 5,2%, respectively.



The income from field crops decreased significantly by 13,8% and is estimated at R107 629 million, largely because of the decrease in income from sunflower seed by 78,0%, maize and cotton (23,0%) each, wheat (9,5%), sugar cane (4,6%) and grain sorghum (2,9%).

The income from horticultural products increased by 5,8% because of the increase in income earned from citrus fruit by 12,8%, deciduous and other fruit by 5,5% and vegetables by 1,3%.

The income from animal products increased by 5,2% due to the increase in income from sheep slaughtered by 12,3%, cattle and calves slaughtered by 7,0%, poultry meat by 6,0% and eggs by 2,8%.

#### Expenditure on intermediate production inputs

*Expenditure on intermediate production inputs refers to the value of goods and services that were purchased to be consumed as inputs during the production process.*

Expenditure on intermediate goods and services decreased by 1,1% and is estimated at R245 836 million for the period ended 30 June 2025. The increase can be attributed to the decrease in expenditure on farm feeds by 6,8%, animal health and crop protection by 6,1%, seed and plants by 4,9% and packing material by 1,3%.

Farm feeds accounted for the largest share of 26,8% to total expenditure on agricultural inputs, followed by fertilisers (14,7%), farm services (10,8%), maintenance and repairs of implements and machinery (9,5%), fuel (8,9%), seed and plants (6,4%), packing material (5,3%), building and fencing material (4,7%) and animal health and crop protection (4,1%).

#### Prices received and paid by farmers

The prices received by farmers for agricultural products increased by 6,0% in 2024/2025, compared to an increase of 6,5% in 2023/2024.

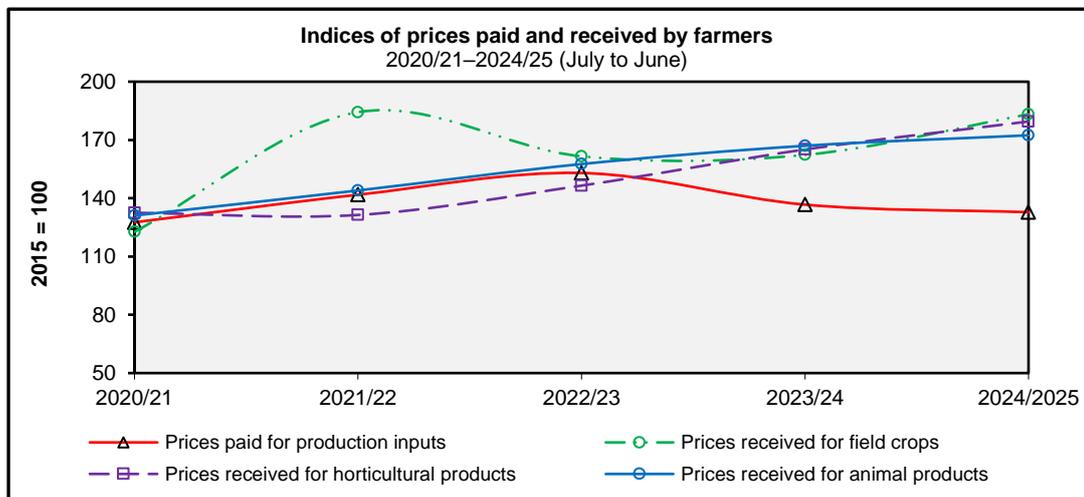
The average price of field crops increased by 12,8% due to the increase in prices of summer grains by 27,5%, tobacco by 24,9%, dry beans by 13,3% and sugar cane by 11,6%. The prices of hay decreased by 12,7%, winter grains and oilseeds by 3,2% each and cotton slightly by 0,3%.

The average price of horticultural products increased by 5,4% and was driven by the increase in prices of fruit by 9,5% and viticulture by 7,4%. The price of vegetables decreased slightly by 0,1%.

The average price of animal products increased by 3,2% due to the increase in prices of slaughtered stock by 7,4%, milk by 3,5% and poultry meat slightly by 0,8%. The price of pastoral products decreased by 8,1%.

The prices paid for farming requisites, including machinery and implements, material for fixed improvements as well as intermediate goods and services decreased by 1,8% in 2024/2025, compared to the decrease of 8,0% in 2023/2024. This was caused by the decrease in prices of animal health and crop protection by 10,8%, fuel by 6,5% and fertilisers slightly by 0,7%.

The domestic terms of trade increased by 7,6% from 1,19 to 1,28 due to better prices that were received from agricultural products in 2024/2025, as well as the decreased production costs.



### Farming income and cash flow

The gross farming income increased slightly by 0,2% while the expenditure on production inputs decreased by 1,1%, leading to a slight increase of 0,2% in net farming income. Interest payment increased by 11,8%, labour remuneration by 3,2% and rent payments by 2,7%.

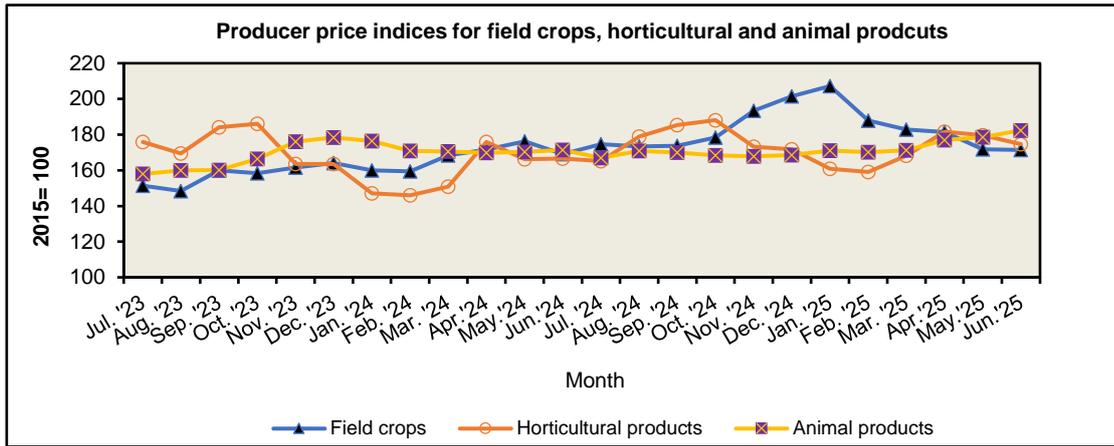
The farmers' cash flow showed a slight decrease of 0,4% and is estimated at R125 659 million in 2024/2025, as opposed to R126 126 million in 2023/2024.

### Conclusion

The gross farming income increased marginally by 0,2% to R457 487 million in 2024/2025. This can be attributed to the increase in production levels of horticultural and animal products, as well as the increase in prices of all agricultural products. Although the prices of field crops increased, a significant decrease in deliveries of major field crops had negatively impacted the gross farming income.

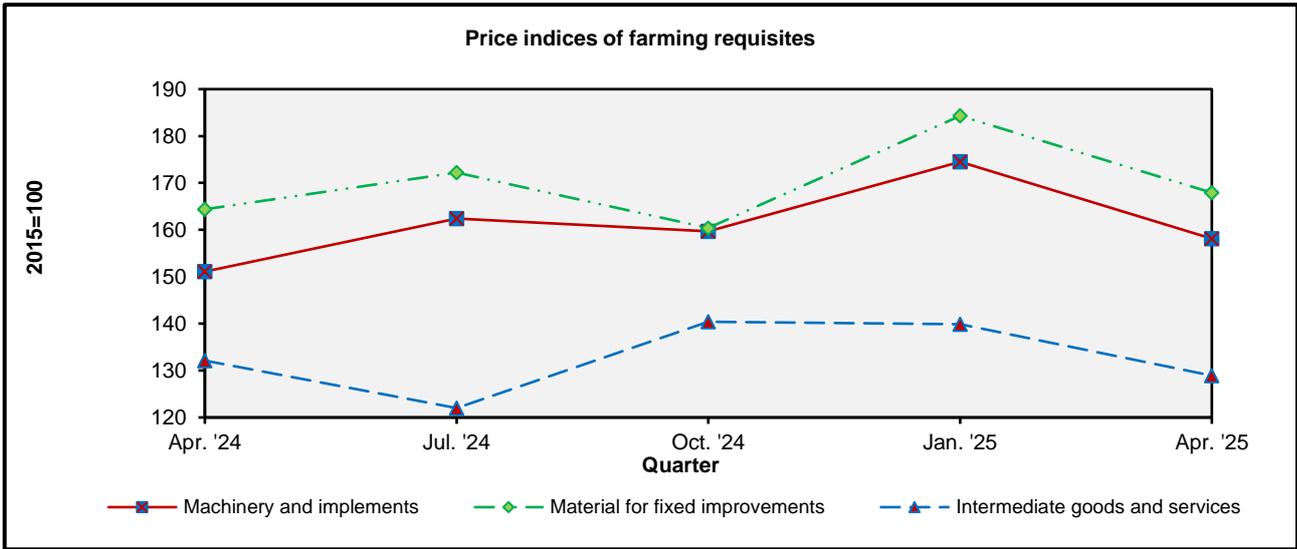

## **SECTION B**

### **FRESH PRODUCE MARKETS OVERVIEW**

#### **FRESH MARKET STATISTICS OF SEASONAL FLUCTUATIONS IN QUANTITIES AND PRICES OF FRUIT AND VEGETABLES SOLD ON THE MAJOR FRESH PRODUCE MARKETS**

The purpose of this overview is to show the short-term price and volume trends (seasonal fluctuations) of various types of fruit and vegetables sold on major fresh produce markets and to make comparisons between the markets.

Market prices are determined by the interaction between supply and demand, which is influenced by various factors. Supply factors include climate, seasonal production, perishability of products and producers' reaction to prices realised in preceding periods, etc. Demand factors include consumer preferences, substitution between products and per capita income. Therefore, the seasonal pattern of quantities sold, and prices realised, may differ considerably among the various markets.
