MIGRATION OF FERTILIZER PRODUCTS FROM GROUP 1 AND 2 TO GROUP 3

The above matter refers.

1. The office of the registrar Act 36 of 1947 requests all fertilizer registration holders whose registrations were previously approved as group 1 (K registration) or 2 (B registration) to note the following:

In terms of the fertilizer regulations (No 972 of 2017) and guidelines on registration for group 3 fertilizers, some of the above products should be group 3 registration. In such cases registration holders are requested to migrate these products to group 3 (M registration) as soon as possible.

2. The process to be followed is:

- a. Apply in a covering letter for migration of the product.
- b. Complete a new application for product registration.
- c. Include proof of payment of the prescribed application fee for a new registration.
- d. The application must meet all the requirements set out in the guidelines for group 3 applications.
- e. The application should be submitted by December 2019.
- f. The current registration will be valid until the renewal cycle ends (or migration).

3. Should the applicant not be able to migrate by the time of renewal, they are advised to request extension from the office of the Registrar, accompanied by the relevant reasons and trial protocol.
4. Failure to migrate products where necessary will result in cancelation of the registration.
