ACT

To repeal the KwaZulu Cane Growers' Association Act, 1981; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

1 Definition

In this Act, unless inconsistent with the context-

'KwaZulu Cane Growers' Association Act' means the KwaZulu Cane Growers' Association Act, 1981 (Act 12 of 1981).

2 Repeal of law

The KwaZulu Cane Growers' Association Act is hereby repealed.

3 Transfer of assets

(1) The assets of the association acquired as a result of levies imposed under section 3 (1) of the KwaZulu Cane Growers' Association Act, including the balance of levies as at the commencement of this Act, must be transferred to a trust to be established in terms of the Trust Property Control Act, 1988 (Act 57 of 1988).

(2) The Minister must appoint suitable persons as trustees to administer the trust.

(3) The assets transferred to the trust contemplated in subsection (1) must be used for the development of small cane growers in KwaZulu-Natal who paid levies in terms of the KwaZulu Cane Growers' Association Act.

4 Short title and commencement

This Act is called the KwaZulu Cane Growers' Association Act Repeal Act, 2002, and comes into operation on a date to be fixed by the President by proclamation in the *Gazette*.
